


Heritage Arts and Sewing Meeting

Important: All funds are issued on a Big R gift card after verification with Chapter/Club Leader has taken place. Limits do apply. Max of 1 large animal and 2 small animal sponsorships per person. Start date to enroll is from March 1st, 2023 to April 15th, 2023. Sign-up is limited to one Big R location. Signing at multiple Big R locations is prohibited. 


