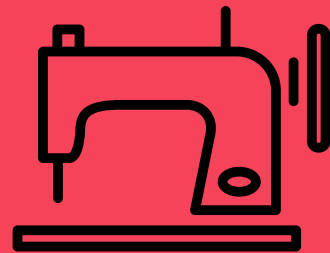
Heritage Arts and Sewing Meeting

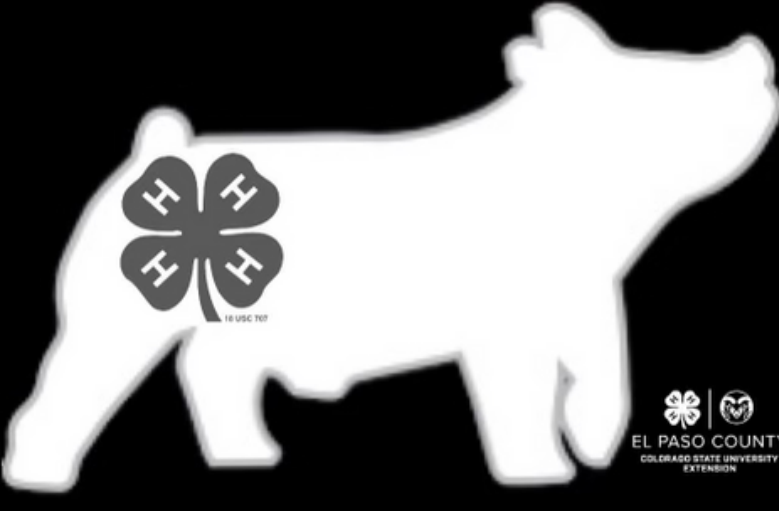
